

The Community Office is a collaborative with agencies in Monroe County and surrounding areas. The people who support the office will provide technical assistance to help students, families, and staff to connect to services and supports. The Community Office volunteers are community agency personnel who are knowledgeable about the Medicaid care coordination system and vocational and rehabilitation services. They can help you gain eligibility/access into the developmental disabilities system, the mental health system or involvement into multiple systems, i.e. probation and alternatives to residential placements. There is no charge for their services.

The participating members of the Community Office share technical expertise for available services including Care Management/Coordination. Care Coordination assists families and individuals with developmental and/or intellectual disabilities to connect with the appropriate services and agencies in the community. Case Management assists families and individuals in multiple systems to access and apply for services and supports. If you are looking for services for an individual with intellectual and/or developmental disabilities, you may call the Office for People with Developmental Disabilities (OPWDD). If you are looking for services for an individual with mental health challenges, you may call the Monroe County Department of Human Services, Office of Mental Health (OMH).
