Residential and Commercial Electrical

Combine theory with handson experience to gain the fundamental skills of electrical wiring and power distribution. Designed for anyone thinking of a career change, job enhancement, or just to acquire a better understanding of electricity in residential and commercial settings. This course is an 18week certificate program.

HVAC/R

Gain the fundamental skills of installing and maintaining heating, ventilation, airconditioning and refrigeration systems. Designed for anyone interested in learning more about climate control systems, for those considering a career change, or those currently working in an entry-level position and ready to expand their skills in the HVAC/R industry.

Residential Construction

This is a comprehensive introduction to residential building construction from rough to finished carpentry and electrical and plumbing. Skills will be taught through classroom instruction and the construction of sheds/ tiny homes. Completion of the certificate programs will introduce students to local contractors, builders and home remodeling companies. Topics will include hand and power tools, construction math, measurement, blueprint reading, floor/wall construction, electrical wiring, basic plumbing, framing, roofing, and finishing. Handson training and projects will reinforce all classroom learning.





Dental Assisting Fundamentals

Students will gain knowledge and hands-on experience in all dental specialties, including dental anatomy/ terminology, instrument care/use and chair-side procedures in a real dental lab with anatomically correct prosthetics and state-of-theart equipment.

LPN Prep Course

This short course will focus on math skills, as well as reading and writing as found on area LPN program entrance exams. Additionally, it includes basic medical terminology, anatomy, and pharmacology to give the student an advantage as they begin their program.

Phlebotomy and Lab Services

Students learn collection and preparation of blood and body fluid specimens using anatomically correct arms, prosthetics and human blood draws, maintenance of records and collection areas.

Nurse Assisting

Prepare to fulfill this vital role in our healthcare industry, providing safety and care to patients and residents in a variety of settings. In addition to technical knowledge and skills learned in the classroom, students will learn how to care for and respect patients and residents with dignity. Manufacturing

Welding

Gain a global understanding of welding, the art and science of joining metal together. Common industry standard processes of Shielded Metal Arc Welding (SMAW-Stick).Gas Tungsten Arc Welding (GTAW-TIG), and Gas Metal Arc Welding (GMAW-MIG), as well as plasma arc and oxy-acetylene cutting are covered.

Machining Fundamentals

This 10 week evening course covers topics such as blueprint reading, machine shop math, drilling, tapping, and reaming. Receive your industry recognized OSHA-10 certificate and gain experience operating the Lathe, Mill, and basics of CNC Machining. The program provides a hybrid learning model that blends skillbuilding in the machine lab with remote learning hours that can count toward an apprenticeship

Industrial and Mechanical Electrical

In the Industrial Electrical program, students will learn the basics of power distribution including transformers, motors, programmable logic controllers, and telecommunications. This class includes skills in diagnostics of electrical equipment and servicing, troubleshooting, and repair. Students will also be introduced to mechatronics and automation. This course is an 18-week certificate program.



Transportation

CDL- Class B

Prepare for the Class B road test in our approved Entry-Level Driver Training (ELDT) program. Students will learn the theory and driving skills necessary to earn their CDL-B with school bus and passenger endorsements.

Forklift Operator Certification

Through theory and practical application, students will learn specific driving rules and techniques, safety legislation, and the skills necessary to safely operate a forklift. The course involves review and testing, both written and practical. The practical portion of the test takes about 15 minutes per student. Upon completion of the program, students are issued a walletsize certificate of completion.

Small Engine Repair

Combine theory and handson experience to gain the skills students will need to repair two-and four-stroke engines. Learn how to make adjustments, do tune-ups, and conduct pre- and post-season maintenance and storage. Applicable equipment includes boats, jetskis, mowers, weed-whackers, tillers, sport ATVs, snowmobiles, snow blowers, and utility ATVs. Each course is taught with the current season's preparations in mind.


