## **COMMON STATE REPORTING ERRORS**

Each type has varying degrees of complexity. Import and Warning/Fatal errors must be resolved before a school district can move their data to the next level of the Data Warehouse. Information/Warning errors allow the data to move, however, the data should be reviewed for necessary corrections prior to finalizing the submission to SIRS

PS3091: W/F - A Preschool Student w/Disability (5786) Program Code can only have an associated enrollment Entry Code (0011/5905) with a Grade Level of "PKF", "PKH", or "PS" during the same time period	This is an enrollment issue. Can happen when a CPSE student is missing a summer enrollment. Can also happen when the ending enrollment date does not match the CPSE exited date in the State Reporting Section.	Fatal
SS4036: W/F - A school age disability program record (0352-0495), for students that are 4 years old on BEDS Day or 5 years old on BEDS Day with a Preschool or Pre-kindergarten Grade Level ("PS"," "PKH" or "PKF"), require an early school age Primary Setting Code in the BEDS Day Snapshot.	Student is reported as an ESA student not School Age nor Preschool Age. The data in State Reporting Section must be manually entered indicating if child is enrolled in a Regular Early Childhood Setting or not. Applies to student who does not turn 5 years old until after BEDS Day or the Kindergarten Aged student who does not enroll in Kindergarten until Mandatory School Age of 6 years old.	Fatal
SS4023: W/F - Missing or Invalid Primary Setting Code in BEDS Day Snapshot.	Missing Primary Setting in State Reporting Section	Fatal
SS4014: W/F - Student must have an active enrollment record in the district on the BEDS Day Snapshot Date	Check for IEP that may not have been exited correctly and is showing up as an active student when in fact has exited.	Fatal
SS4024: W/F - Missing or Invalid Primary Service Provider for preschool student in BEDS Day Snapshot.	Missing Primary Service Provider in State Reporting Section or have wrong provider code.	Fatal
SS4035: W/F - A school age disability program record (0352-0495), for students that are 5-21 years old on BEDS Day with a K-14 or "GD" Grade Level, require a school age Primary Setting Code in the BEDS Day Snapshot	Missing Primary Setting Code in State Reporting Section.	Fatal
PS3107: Missing or Invalid demographic record	Student has probably moved and one or more Documents with the same start date have not been exited correctly. No draft is needed if the student exited before receiving services for the year. If there are two documents, BOTH must be exited.	Information/Wa rning
PS3055: W/F - A Change in Disability Exit Reason Code 1 (912) must have a subsequent disability record with a different disability program service code.	As long as the CPSE IEP is exited with "Moved Known to Continue", there will be no end date on the TOD, and no 912 code since they were exited prior to the CSE IEP starting.	Fatal
EV5040: W/F - Number of days must be greater than zero, since Event Outcome equals "Y", this chain has no link 04 (El04) and 2024-08-31 is past 3rd birthday.	Student is missing the Process Tracking Entry of: Started Education Services	Fatal
EE2098: W/F - An enrollment Entry Code of "0021" is required for a student with a disability that is enrolled on the day they turn 22 years of age during the current school year: & bad data	On the day a student with disabilities turns 22 years old and is receiving compensatory or recovery services, they must be enrolled with "0021" enrollment Entry Code	Fatal
