Day Habilitation Skills Continuum: Adult Services

→→→ Increasing integration and community involvement and decreasing supports →→→

Skills and expectations are cumulative. As they move up the continuum, participants must have the skills identified in the previous, more supported level of programming.

***This information is generalized and expectations and support available can vary from agency to agency


	Site Based Day Habilitation Programs	Without Walls Day Habilitation Programs
	Some site-based day habs include a higher level of community integration/outings and require a higher level of independence medically and behaviorally. All staff are med certified, and nursing is available but not onsite. Activities may include recreation, skill building in the community, fitness, volunteering, functional/community academics, etc.	Participants are located almost 100% in the community. They engage in volunteer work, recreation and leisure activities, classes, etc. based on their individual and group goals. The group may "hub" at a site or go directly into the community from home.
Communication	 Must be able to initiate communication (verbally, using a device, nonverbally) and engage with a communication partner to get their needs met. The communication partner may then take the lead to facilitate their communication. Must be able to make choices regarding activities with minimal to moderate support 	- Participants must be able to initiate and clearly communicate their needs, verbally or utilizing a device or other tool with minimal support

Behavior	 Participants must be able to manage their stress and frustration without resorting to verbally or physically aggressive/threatening behaviors toward self and others Participants must be able to self-regulate with mild to moderate verbal support and be able to do so in the presence of other staff and participants (private space may or may not be available). Participants must have a variety of tools they can use to re-regulate. "Taking a walk" will rarely be an option. Participants must be able to meet their sensory needs in smaller, more crowed environments. Sensory rooms, swings, etc. will rarely be available. Participants must be able to manage sexual behaviors appropriately including respecting the boundaries of others (verbally and physically) Participants must be able to manage their behavior and social judgement in the community with minimal to moderate support including respecting boundaries, interacting appropriately with others, managing food and objects safely and appropriately. Participants must be able to function as part of a group in a small setting. Participants may not have a dedicated work area and will have to share equipment, tools, and supplies. 	 Must be able to self-regulate and meet sensory needs with a high level of independence and in community settings. Participants must be able to participate in the community every day. There is not an option to "stay back" if the individual is having a difficult day. Must be able to engage in non-preferred activities with minimal support Must be able to manage transitions with minimal support.
	Note: These sites are often smaller and could be as small as one or two rooms. Participants must be able to exist in those sites without causing significant disturbance to others (volume, sensory, physical needs, boundaries, etc.)	Note: This type of day hab requires participants to demonstrate a high level of maturity, problem solving, community and personal safety, communication, and interpersonal skills.

*** If your student needs a higher level of support than listed above, some agencies do have site-based day habs that provide very high medical and behavioral levels of support. These facilities provide very high levels of supervision at program and out in the community. Staff can provide significant to total support in all areas. At these day habs:

- Participants must be able to receive care from a variety of people.
- Nursing and clinical services may be available on site.
- 1:1 nursing may not be allowed; this varies from agency to agency

Notes: There are not enough openings at the programs with the highest level of support currently to meet the need. New entrants are prioritized based on urgency, availability of family support and the ability of the agency to meet their needs given the exiting participant group. Applicants are turned away every year by all agencies due to space.
