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## **Summary Notes:**

CSE students must have at least the first three action types to complete state reporting requirements

- Receipt of Referral
- Consent for Initial Evaluation Received
- Log Action re: the Initial Eligibility Meeting (1 of 3 choices depending on what occurred)
- Started Special Education Services \*\*Required for Non-Pub Students (optional for all other CSE students, but recommended for all)

CPSE students must have at least the first three log action types to complete state reporting requirements

- Receipt of Referral
- Consent for Initial Evaluation Received
- Log Action re: the Initial Eligibility Meeting (1 of 3 choices depending on what occurred)
- Started Special Education Services (optional for CPSE but recommended for all)

## If the preschool child is transitioning from EI services to CPSE:

CPSE students must have at least four log action types to complete state reporting requirements

- Receipt of Referral
- Consent for Initial Evaluation Received
- Log Action re: the Initial Eligibility Meeting (1 of 2 choices depending on what occurred)
  - o Initial Meeting Eligibility Determined OR
  - o EI/CPSE Initial Eligibility Not Determined/Not Convened by Report Deadline
- -started Special Education Services, if eligibility determined
- -EI/CPSE IEP Not Implemented by Report Deadline (08/31/XXXX), if referral withdrawn, moved prior to meeting or chose to stay in EI
