

# Monroe BOCES Bank



Allowing this Bank to be added to your district's eDoctrina account will open the following capabilities:

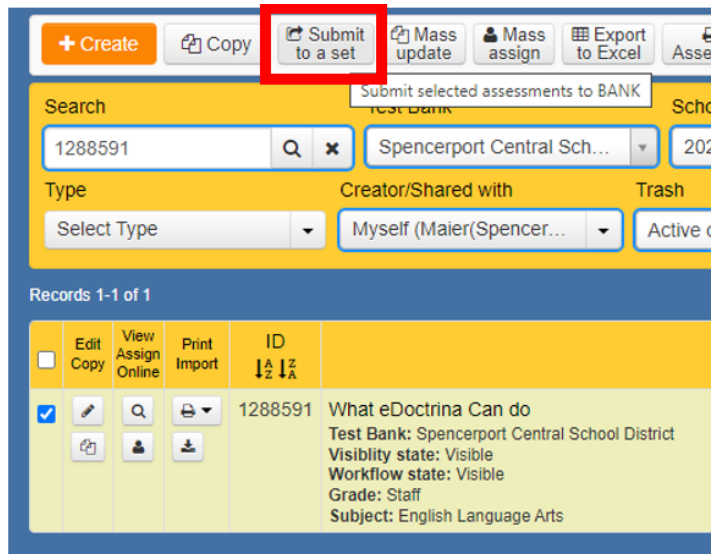
## 1. The ability to copy items created by others in the region to use in your district.

By selecting the Monroe BOCES Bank, users will be able to preview units, assessments, and questions that were submitted by colleagues in other districts. These items will be editable once copied from the Monroe BOCES Bank. The original copy will not be affected. Materials developed by BOCES will also be hosted here, including training materials, commonly used rubrics, and benchmark templates. **All materials are vetted by MAARS and MAARS will ask districts for permission to share before being visible to all.**

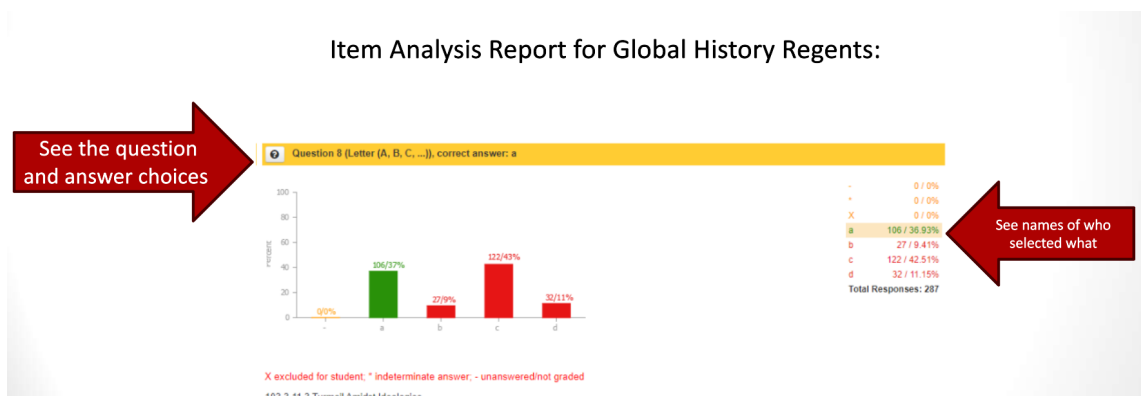
## 2. The ability for those in your district to submit items for the purpose of sharing outside your district.

If a user created something they wanted to share with other districts, they could submit the item(s) to the Monroe BOCES Bank. So a Social Studies teacher who created a great assessment based on the new Framework exam could submit to the Monroe BOCES Bank to help colleagues in other districts get started! Regional Curriculum teams could use this to share materials!



## 3. Have BOCES MAARS help get your NYS Exam data into eDoctrina quickly!

The Level 1 Data Warehouse has eDoctrina exports to quickly get your data in the system. You will gain access to 3-8 and Regents copies that match the Level 1 exports. With a click of a few buttons, you can have your teachers access reports/data once only available with a Data Warehouse account! Teachers would love to have things like the Standards Report and Item Analysis Report available for their incoming rosters!
