NEW VISIONS IS:

A one-year career exploration program that provides highly motivated seniors with the opportunity to gain valuable insights into career options from a real-world perspective.

Area businesses, colleges, health care and government facilities provide the setting for immersed learning in a career field of interest to the student.

Students have the opportunity to:

- Network with industry professionals
- Participate in job shadowing
- Earn high school and college credits

New Visions classes meet Monday-Friday, from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. When students are not shadowing in a professional location, they are on field trips or in their dedicated New Visions classroom. School districts provide transportation.

New Visions is the only senior year educational experience that provides a full year of real world career immersion.

CAREER EXPLORATION INCLUDES:

- Shadowing professionals
- Participating in industry tours and field trips
- Interviewing professionals in the field
- Engaging with guest speakers
- Professional networking
- Developing mentoring contacts



IMPORTANT POINTS TO REMEMBER

- New Visions is a career exploration program. It is not a skills training program.
- New Visions students have the opportunity to shadow professionals. The program is not an internship. Students do not provide services to clients or patients.
- Students with a pre-determined professional goal will be assigned to a variety of careers to experience the interconnectedness between occupations.
- There is an application and acceptance process required for all New Visions students.

ACADEMIC CREDITS

Students earn 3 high school credits for New Visions

- ↗ 1 credit for Government/Economics
- ↗ 2 elective credits

Depending on their program, students can earn dual enrollment credit for college courses including:

- ↗ HED 130-Foundations of Personal Health and Wellness
- ↗ ECO 101- Economics
- ↗ SPC 143- Small Group Communication

ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS

- College-bound high school juniors with interest in the career field represented by the New Visions class
- Academic requirements:
 - ↗ Completion of 3 years of Regents math and Regents science
 - ↗ A score of 76 or higher on the ELA Regents exam
 - ↗ Preference will be given to students who also score 85 or higher on the Geometry Regents OR 70 or higher on the Algebra 2 Regents
- No behavior, attendance or discipline concerns during junior year
- Able to successfully complete industry requirements for placement, which may include a background check, drug test and/or vaccinations
