# **Challenger Baseball**

Challenger Baseball is an official division of Little League International. The division was created in 1989 with the objective to give kids with physical and developmental challenges the opportunity to play the great game of baseball.

Players are ages 4 -18, and up to 22 if they are enrolled in a school program.

Locally we have over 300 players in Little League town programs; Brighton, Webster, Penfield, Fairport, Pittsford, Victor, Rush Henrietta, Honeoye Falls, and Greece. You do not have to live on one of the towns just mentioned for your child to play there. We find the town program that fits best for you.

The format of play accommodates all. All players get to bat each inning and then play the field. No score is kept. Just a lot of fun hitting the ball, running the bases, catching and throwing the ball in the field; some with the assistance of an assigned Buddy to help in play and keeping the players safe.

A Challenger Buddy is a volunteer, usually a player from one of the traditional house league teams, who helps a player who needs assistance. If a player can't swing a bat, they help. If a player is in a wheelchair, they push them around the bases. If a player needs a little protection on the field, their Buddy is at their side for those hard hit ground balls. Sometimes the player just wants someone to hang out in the field or help them in the batters box.
