Monroe 2-Orleans BOCES Policy Series 2000 – Community Relations Policy #2411 – UNLAWFUL POSSESSION OF A WEAPON UPON SCHOOL GROUNDS

The possession of any firearm or weapon or a look alike firearm or weapon, as defined in New York State Law, Federal Law or Board policy, on BOCES premises or BOCES property is prohibited, except: 1) by law enforcement personnel, 2) upon written authorization of the District Superintendent/designee, 3) an antique firearm used for instructional purposes with prior notice.

The terms "BOCES premises" or "BOCES property" shall mean property owned or leased by the BOCES and shall also include BOCES activities off premises such as field trips or work based programs.
